This program represents an opportunity to bridge social capital as well as identify, train and provide employment pathways and networks for disadvantaged people. For all participants it is an opportunity to improve self esteem, develop communication and leadership potential. Participants will learn how to work as a team to meet challenges by unlocking their creative potential. Casual mentoring and networking will be encouraged.

Migrants who are unemployed and disadvantaged people with health care cards and disability cards may attend for free. Students and pensioners pay an annual fee amounting to approximately \$8 per week, and others will pay an annual fee amounting to approximately \$10 per week.
